HOW SKIN CHANGES WITH AGE

Over time, your skin begins to change as a result of sun exposure, lifestyle, and the natural aging process.

- Lines appear on your face from the repeated expressions you make
- Wrinkles form, and your face appears leaner due to loss of volume and decreased levels of collagen and facial fat
- Looseness and puffiness occur under the eyes, cheeks, and jaw from the pull of gravity as the skin becomes less elastic
- Etched-in lines form from constant facial activity

Fortunately, a variety of options are available to help treat wrinkles for a more youthful-looking you.



LINE TREATMENT

Neuromodulators soften facial creases and lines that form over time.

Each smile, frown, or squint you make contributes to the wrinkles that appear on your face.

When you make an expression, lines form on your face as muscles under the skin contract.

- Repeated expressions cause the appearance of lines between your eyebrows
- Over time, these lines can become constantly visible, even when your face is at rest
- Neuromodulators are injected into these areas to temporarily prevent the muscle activity that causes these lines to form

Left untreated, some of these facial lines may leave you with an unintentional worried or angry expression. Neuromodulators are specifically designed to relax specific muscles for a time, allowing your face to appear more serene.

Reducing the use of facial muscles with a neuromodulator can help smooth the appearance of expression lines for 3 to 4 months. While the effects of an injection are not immediately apparent, results are typically visible after a few days.



INJECTABLE FILLERS HELP SMOOTH WRINKLES AND FOLDS BY RESTORING VOLUME TO THE AGING FACE

Through the years, the skin's natural youthful appearance begins to diminish due to the following factors:

- The skin begins to lose collagen, elastin, and hyaluronic acid (HA)
- Some of the structural volume within the face is lost
- The skin becomes more prone to develop lines and wrinkles

When injected under the skin, fillers add volume to the tissue and push out the wrinkles and folds, unlike neuromodulators that treat wrinkles by relaxing the muscle beneath the skin.

In addition to softening facial creases and wrinkles, some fillers are FDA approved to*:

- Provide lift and volume in the cheeks
- Restore fullness to thin lips
- Correct shallow contours

Depending on the type of filler, results are immediate and may last up to 4 months to more than a year in some patients.



What is the most important information I should know about RADIESSE® and RADIESSE® (+)?

If RADIESSE® or RADIESSE® (+) are injected into a blood vessel, serious complications can result, including stroke, vision abnormalities, blindness, temporary scabs, and permanent scars.

As with all procedures that involve an injection through the skin, there is a risk of infection. Do not use RADIESSE® or RADIESSE® (+) if you have a skin infection until it has healed. It is not known if RADIESSE® or RADIESSE® (+) is safe or effective in the lips, or in the area around the eyes.

The microspheres in RADIESSE® and RADIESSE® (+) can be seen in X-rays and CT Scans. It is very important that you tell your health care provider that you have had RADIESSE® or RADIESSE® (+) dermal filler injected into your face.



RADIESSE® FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What is RADIESSE® made of?

RADIESSE is made of tiny calcium-based microspheres that are suspended in a natural, water-based gel. These calcium-based microspheres are similar to minerals that are found naturally in your body, so allergy testing is not required. Over time, your body absorbs these tiny microspheres and the gel, leaving behind only your own natural collagen.

2. How soon can I expect results after a RADIESSE treatment?

Instantly! Immediately upon injection, RADIESSE adds volume to wrinkles and folds to help smooth out the signs of aging.

3. How long does RADIESSE last?

Not only does RADIESSE provide immediate correction, the natural, smooth results may last a year or more in many patients.

4. Is treatment with RADIESSE uncomfortable?

RADIESSE is FDA approved to mix with lidocaine (an anesthetic). That means you can experience a more comfortable wrinkle treatment. In fact, in a clinical study, using RADIESSE mixed with lidocaine significantly reduced pain in 90% of patients treated with RADIESSE.

5. How long is the recovery time after RADIESSE treatment?

There is very little downtime involved with a RADIESSE procedure. As with any injection, patients may experience side effects, such as mild irritation, swelling, itching, redness, bruising, or tenderness at the injection site, which typically resolve on their own. If any of these side effects persist, contact your health care professional right away. Every patient is unique, so be sure to discuss your plans with a health care provider.



As you age, moderate-to-severe etched-in lines may start to appear near the surface of the skin, resulting in a less youthful appearance.

Every time you speak, eat, kiss, or smile, your skin remembers these movements, and lines eventually begin to form. Even something as simple as drinking through a straw can eventually create lasting facial lines that only deepen with time. A quick glance in the mirror may show these etched-in lines, including:

- Vertical lines appearing above and below your lips
- Smile lines forming around your mouth
- Downturned lines developing at the corners of your mouth

These etched-in lines are often most noticeable at a closer, more personal distance. Maybe you've seen them around the mouth of a friend when you talk together, or while you are examining your face as you apply makeup. At times, vertical lines above and below the lips may actually seem highlighted when a bright shade of lipstick bleeds into them.

What is BELOTERO BALANCE?

BELOTERO BALANCE® is a prescription injection that is approved to temporarily smooth out and fill in moderate-to-severe nasolabial folds (the folds or wrinkles that go from the side of the nose to the corner of the mouth).

While some fillers are approved to shape and contour, BELOTERO BALANCE® is approved to treat wrinkles and folds, such as nasolabial folds, and can be an ideal option to smooth moderate-to-severe etched-in lines and wrinkles.

What should I tell my doctor before injections with BELOTERO BALANCE?

1. What is BELOTERO BALANCE® made of?

BELOTERO BALANCE is made of a substance called hyaluronic acid (HA), a natural component of skin. The HA in BELOTERO BALANCE is specially formulated in a proprietary process to create a uniquely smooth and cohesive gel. This injectable gel blends into the natural structure of your skin, gently filling moderate-to-severe etched-in lines and wrinkles and creating a smooth, natural look and feel.

2. How soon can I expect results after a BELOTERO BALANCE treatment?

Immediately upon treatment, BELOTERO BALANCE helps smooth etched-in lines and wrinkles, such as vertical lip lines above and around your lips.

3. How long does BELOTERO BALANCE last?

Individual results may vary, but BELOTERO BALANCE may last about 6 months or more. Some factors that affect how long it lasts are the amount of product used and the area it is injected into. In areas that experience a lot of movement due to eating, talking, and smiling, the product may not last as long as other, less active areas.

4. Does BELOTERO BALANCE hurt?

1. Why is RADIESSE® an ideal filler for hands?

RADIESSE is the FIRST and ONLY dermal filler deemed safe and effective by the FDA to restore lost volume to hands. RADIESSE is also the ONLY filler approved for use in hands and face, which means that no other filler currently used in the face is approved for treating hands. In addition, this unique gel has the ability to reduce the appearance of tendons and veins, as well as stimulate the body to produce its own collagen.

2. How soon can I expect results after a treatment with RADIESSE for Hands?

For approximately 24 hours after treatment, avoid:

- strenuous activity
- extensive sun or heat exposure
- aspirin or non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs
- alcoholic beverages

Exposure to any of the above can cause temporary redness, swelling, and/or itching at the injection site.

It is not known how BELOTERO BALANCE will work in areas of the face other than the smile lines.

It is not known how BELOTERO BALANCE will work in women who are pregnant or breastfeeding or people who are less than 21 years of age.

What should I tell my doctor before injections with BELOTERO BALANCE?

Tell your doctor if you are taking medicines that affect blood clotting, like aspirin, an NSAID or warfarin. These medicines may put you at an increased risk of bruising or bleeding at the treatment site.

Tell your doctor if you have a skin reaction like cold sores, cysts, pimples, rashes, hives, or an infection. Treatment with BELOTERO BALANCE should be delayed until the reaction goes away.

Tell your doctor if you are taking medicines that affect your immune system.

What are the most common adverse events seen with BELOTERO BALANCE?

The most common local side effects seen with BELOTERO BALANCE were swelling, bruising, redness, hardening of the skin, pain, altered color, or itching. Other side effects that have occurred with BELOTERO BALANCE include headache, swelling of the side of the nose, moderate cold sore, lip numbness, and lip dryness. Side effects were often mild to moderate and often resolved within 7 days.
